2020 VAIL LACROSSE SHOOTOUT

Hello: Plans for the 2020 Vail Lacrosse Shootout are underway and you can now request a spot in the Men's Grandmasters and Zenmasters Divisions. Below is information about these Division of the Shootout and how you can request your spot for the 2020 event.

Requesting your spot/entry fee. To request a spot please complete the attached Request for Entry form and return it to Connie Streich at vaillaxinfo@comcast.net by December 15, 2019. A deposit of \$500 is also due with your entry (this deposit is non-refundable after 1/15/20). If paying the deposit by check, the check should be made payable to International Lacrosse Promotions and mailed to International Lacrosse Promotions c/o Connie Streich, 7056 Turweston Lane, Castle Pines, CO 80108. If you prefer to pay with a credit card, you can call me at 303-886-3500 with your credit card information. You can also pay via Paypal – go to: <http://vaillacrosse.com/about/registration/>. Select Men, then go to the Men's Grandmasters or Zenmasters Div. The team entry fee for a Grandmasters team is \$1,900. The entry fee for a Zenmasters team is \$1,300.

Team Selection. After January 15th you will be notified if you have a spot in this division. If you are a returning team from last year, you will be given your spot for 2020, however you do need to return the Request for Entry form with updated contact information (two contacts are required) and your deposit. 2020 Dates: Both Grandmasters & Zenmasters will play Saturday, June 27 through Monday, June 29. Tournament dates for all divisions are attached.

Age: Grandmasters players must be at least 50 (a player can turn 50 sometime during calendar year 2020 and still be eligible). Zenmasters players must be at least 60 (a player can turn 60 sometime during calendar year 2020 and be eligible).

US Lacrosse: All U.S. players and coaches must be current members of U.S. Lacrosse. If your team will include Canadian or international players please let us know as we will need to purchase insurance for them (our expense).

Grandmasters/Zenmasters/Supermasters cross-over players: Players will be allowed to play on both a Supermasters and a Grandmasters or Grandmasters and a Zenmasters team provided they are on the roster for each team from the beginning and meet the age requirement for the older division. Supermasters dates are also June 27 through June 29.

Travel/Accommodations : Erik Tilley of Peak Sports Travel will again be the official travel provider for the Shootout. Eric has been involved with our event for many years and is very familiar with the needs of teams. Erik has contracted with many hotels/condominium complexes in the Vail Valley and can help you locate team lodging as well as assist with air travel, ground transportation and booking other activities for the team while in Vail. Miscell: Only 4 long sticks will be allowed on the field at a time. Teams must have 2 separate colors of jerseys with LEGIBLE from a distance numbers on front and back.
