

**INVITATION TO MEN'S MASTERS DIVISION
2020 VAIL LACROSSE SHOOTOUT
JULY 2, 3 and 4, 2020**

Hello: Plans for the 2020 Vail Lacrosse Shootout are underway and you may now request a spot in the Men's Masters Division. Below is information about the Men's Masters Division of the Shootout and how you can request your spot for the 2020 event.

Requesting your spot/entry fee: To request a spot please complete the attached Request for Entry form and return it to Connie Streich at vaillaxinfo@comcast.net before December 15, 2020. A deposit of \$500 will also be due by that date (this deposit is non-refundable after 1/1/20). Options for paying the deposit are: 1) mailing a check made payable to International Lacrosse Promotions c/o Connie Streich, 7056 Turweston Lane, Castle Pines, CO 80108; 2) call my cell (303-886-3500) with credit card information; or 3) via Paypal – go to: <http://vaillacrosse.com/about/registration/>. Select Men, then go to the Men's Masters Div. The team entry fee is \$1,800.00

Team Selection: If you are a returning team from last year, you will be given your spot for 2020, however you do need to return the Request for Entry form with updated contact information (two contacts are required) and the deposit. We want to increase the number of teams in this division in 2020. If you know of anyone that might be interested in bringing a Masters team please ask them to email me at vaillaxinfo@comcast.net and I will send them information.

2020 Dates: The Men's Masters Division will play Thursday, July 2 through Saturday, July 4. The tournament schedule for all divisions is attached.

Age: Masters players must be at least 30. A player can turn 30 sometime during calendar year 2020 and still be eligible.

US Lacrosse: All U.S. players and coaches must be current members of U.S. Lacrosse. If your team will include Canadian or international players please let us know as we will need to purchase insurance for them (our expense).

Cross-Over players: Players will be allowed to play on both a Masters and a Supermasters (age 40 & up) or Elite Div. team provided they are on the roster for each team from the beginning and meet the age requirement for the older division. Elite dates are July 2 through July 5; Supermasters dates are June 27, 28 & 29.

Miscellaneous: Only 4 long sticks will be allowed on the field at a time. Teams must have 2 separate colors of jerseys with LEGIBLE from a distance numbers on front and back.

Travel/Accommodations: Erik Tilley of Peak Sports Travel will again be the official travel provider for the Shootout. Eric has been involved with our event for many years and is very familiar with the needs of teams. Erik has contracted with many hotels/condominium complexes in the Vail Valley and can help you locate team lodging as well as assist with air travel, ground transportation and booking other activities for the team while in Vail.
